

Fee Agreement for Assessment Services

1. Psychological testing involves face-to-face assessment procedures, typically administered in a private office and often involving several hours over two or more sessions.

2. Psychological testing also involves scoring and interpreting test results and the preparation of a written report. These tasks often take as many hours to complete as the time spent face-to-face with the client makes up about 1/3 of the time involved. A number of tasks can add to the cost of an assessment.

These may include:

- Home or school visits
- Review of documents (e.g., prior reports)
- Contact with other pertinent individuals or professionals (e.g., teachers, therapists or doctors)
- The administration of special test procedures to better identify a specific problem or need.

3. Costs for a full battery of testing can range from approximately \$3,500.00 to \$4,500.00. In most cases, individuals can expect a typical battery to include about twelve+ hours of time and cost around \$4,200.00 - \$4600.00.

4. Dr. Sorci charges an hourly rate of \$375.00 for all services. A deposit of \$1,500.00 is due at the first meeting or session; however, if working hourly (\$375/hr.) on a specific area of testing only (e.g., I.Q. testing for school admission), the deposit is not required. The person(s) financially responsible for the account will be billed for the balance due upon completion of the testing, before final data is released.

_____ Initials acknowledging that a deposit is due at first testing appointment or half of the estimated hourly.

5. The final report will not be released until the balance due is paid in full. _____ Initials

6. If you need to cancel your scheduled appointment you must notify Dr. Sorci 48 hours prior to your appointment. If you do not notify Dr. Sorci 48 hours prior to your appointment you will be charged the full amount for the time that was set aside for your needs.

7. Psychological assessment is a specialty and may only be performed by individuals with the proper training, experience and license. Because of the special training, costly materials, and skills required, psychological assessment is expensive and unfortunately, rarely covered by insurance.

8. Dr. Sorci does not accept payment through any insurance or managed care company. The person(s) financially responsible for the account will be provided with an itemized statement following the release of the final report. The statement confirms receipt of the initial deposit and final payment; it is itemized and correlates charges with appropriate CPT codes.
